



GRAFT CARE

1. Our dressing should remain in place for 48 hours.
2. After 48 hours, clean the graft site twice-daily using soap and water.
3. With a clean applicator, spread a generous layer of polysporin ointment over the graft.
4. Cover the graft using non-stick bandage, cotton ball, and tape in place, until you return to the office for suture removal.
5. It is very important that the graft is moist, protected from movement, and covered. The cotton ball insures the graft is in contact with the wound base, which is vital for the graft to survive.
6. You may have some drainage from the wound, this is normal. If drainage becomes yellow, green, or foul smelling, notify our office immediately at 386-677-9044 option 4 (nurse's station) or if after hours, please call the office at 386-677-9044 and wait for the prompt for the answering service and they will get in touch with a provider.
7. If possible and approved by your primary physician, avoid aspirin and aspirin containing products. Take plain Tylenol if needed for discomfort.
